This designation means that in 2025 from Armed Forces Day, May 17, to Labor Day, September 1, the house will provide free admission to activeduty personnel and their families (excluding special events). The CDHF has long-given free admission to active duty personnel. The Colonel Davenport House will be listed on the Blue Star Museum's website, interactive map, and other program materials.


EAGLE SCOUT HELPS THE COLONEL DAVENPORT HOUSE

After attending the Scout Camporee on Arsenal Island in September 2023, Andrew Amacher wanted to complete his Eagle Scout project somewhere on the island. He decided to work with the CDHF and replace the ramp for the house. After getting Council's approval, Andrew got right to work in order to complete the project by his 18th birthday per Eagle Scout rules. Andrew scheduled work days in mid-September 2024 with the rest of Troop 258 and adult assistance. The new ramp is slightly wider than the previous one and better built with a secure



foundation. There is a larger landing with benches added by the CDHF. Andrew had his Eagle Scout ceremony at the beginning of May. In the next newsletter, we'll share details on the other Eagle Scout project completed.
